## **Archbishop John C. Wester on the Ethics of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine**

ALBUQUERQUE – Wednesday, March 3, 2021–IMMEDIATE RELEASE-- Archbishop John C. Wester’s statement on the ethics of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine:

The FDA approval of the latest COVID-19 single dose vaccine produced by Johnson and Johnson is good news. This is especially so for those in rural parts of New Mexico where the requirement of two doses can be burdensome. Along with the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines already in use, this latest vaccine moves us even closer to herd immunity and the protection of human life.

Since there are some who may be worried that the Johnson and Johnson vaccine is not ethical, I wish to assure all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe that in the current pandemic and given the limited vaccine options available to achieve healing for our nation and our world, it is entirely morally acceptable to receive this one dose Johnson and Johnson vaccine or either of the other two (Pfizer or Moderna). Indeed, Pope Francis has made it clear that by being vaccinated we are exhibiting a genuine love of our neighbor and a regard for the sanctity of human life.
