Affidavit of Sponsor

The Church requires the presence of a sponsor for the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. The sponsor assumes the role of a spiritual parent and commits to actively supporting the newly Baptized or Confirmed Catholic by good example and instruction in the Christian life.

In order to be admitted to the role of sponsor, the law of the Church states that a person must be designated specifically by the parents of the child or the individual who is to be baptized or confirmed as an adult. A sponsor must be a fully-initiated Catholic (Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation) and be at least sixteen years of age. Additionally, he or she must be actively living their faith and leading a life in harmony with the Catholic faith.
