- Parish Updates
 - Pastoral planning team has been formed to discuss the goals for the Parish to focus on for the next 18-24 months as set forth in the Mission and Ministry 2015 initiative. - Deacon Jack's replacement will be Carol Moses who will take over as Director of Liturgy. An assistant to the Director of Liturgy is now available for hire.
- A new Youth Minister, Bryan Smyth, has been hired.
- Kaitlin Crews is leaving her position as the Parish Secretary Assistant and her position is available for hire.
- The timeline for the new storage area is forecasted for summer of 2013. Father Sean is hoping that by July 4th, the new building will be completed.
- The area by the mailboxes needs to be more inviting and match the architecture of the other buildings. Father Sean is working with the PLC Contractor to attain a quote.
- Transitioning of the prep school, library and staff offices into the PLC has started and will hopefully be fully completed by end of summer.
- CTR will give \$6000 this year for the scholarship matching program and University of St. Thomas (UST) will match dollar to dollar. This year there are 12 students from CTR attending UST who can benefit from this program.
