Open Forum

Information Sharing

- Parish Updates
 - The Council was presented with a financial review given by Marilyn from the Financial Council.
 - Priority plan was discussed at all masses on 9-21 & 9-22. Father Sean requested the feedback from the Council. As discussed, the Council generally felt that the information was well received. Father Sean requested to put the goals on future Council meeting agendas.
 - The online school survey resulted in 265 replies and will be discussed at October Council meeting.
 - The new playground construction is underway. A concern was raised about the sand pit that will be constructed regarding attraction for animals and tracking

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sand into the building. Concrete will begin pouring for the trike path and the new steps on the north side of the PLC. A concern was raised about a cover for the playground. Deacon Phillip will look into the design to be able to respond.

- Father Sean updated the Council on the Genesis program. 210 students are enrolled which brings enrollment to 97%.
- The Council was updated that Father Sean is looking into the ADA doors at one entrance of the Church. The pump at the baptismal fountain was broken and there are repairs in works.
- Reconstruction of the back entrance area has a proposal for a new architectural design for the entrance. The idea has been tabled until a future date.
- Father Sean requested feedback on the grounds of CTR. The Council discussed the landscape of CTR.
- The new Director of Communication has been involved with social media and started revamping the CTR website. She has been working on getting Flocknotes up and running. Flocknotes is a communication tool for parishioners in which they can opt-in for notifications.

Open Discussion

- Express Concerns and Requests of Parishioners:
 - A parishioner inquired about a between jobs ministry. There will be further discussion, but as of now CTR's main social outreach is CAM. The Council further discussed CAM and brought up that more communication needs to be disseminated regarding CTRs' involvement with CAM.
 - A concern was brought up regarding the confusion in the pickup/drop off for the RE class. Proposal for additional stops in the drives as well as other safety signs/cones. Conversation broke out to have crossing guards.
