- 1) The base salary of \$1680 monthly is increased to \$1880 effective July 1, 2019
- 2) The compensation scale for years of priestly service, presently a \$5 increase for every year of priestly service and capped at 25 years, will be increased to \$10 for every year of priestly service and will be capped at forty years of service (please see the compensation scale attached). This is effective July 1, 2019
- 3) Beginning fiscal year 2020-2021 a 1.5% COLA will be added to the base salary
- 4) Retired priests will receive the same base salary increase and all retired priests will receive the maximum compensation amount (\$400) for years of priestly service. Regarding those priests that served additional years beyond retirement age and thus receive a percentage amount above the 100%, their retirement compensation will be calculated according to the appropriate percentage. Beginning in fiscal year 2020-2021 the retired priests will receive a 1.5% COLA added to the base salary.
