## Thirty First Sunday in Ordinary Time

### Theme/Call To Worship

The readings present harsh remarks directed against the religious leadership in the time of the prophet Malachi and in Jesus' time. These criticisms offer all of us an opportunity to examine our own behavior as Christians.

### Introduction To The Word

**Mal 1:14b—2:2b, 8-10:** In the first reading, Malachi criticizes the priests of his day for leading the people astray in both words and deeds. The historical context for these criticisms is important to note: factors such as the dispersion (scattering) of the Jews upon their return from Babylon and a destroyed capital city (Jerusalem) and Temple combined with new forms of worship (synagogues) led to a certain destabilization of the faith traditions and customs.

**1 Thes 2:7b-9, 13:** In his interactions with the Thessalonians, Paul established a sense of orthodoxy, a template for leadership within the early Christian communities. As leader, treat your community "as a nursing mother cares for her children." As leader, never lose sight of your primary role, to proclaim "the gospel of God."

**Mt 23:1-12:** In today's Gospel, Jesus denounced the religious leaders of his day (the Pharisees and Scribes) not so much for their words, but for their deeds. Jesus begins by acknowledging the authority of their position (they "have taken their seat on the chair of Moses") and therefore the legitimacy of their words ("do and observe all things whatsoever they tell you"). But Jesus separates their authorial position and the tradition it represents from their actual deeds ("but do not follow their example").
