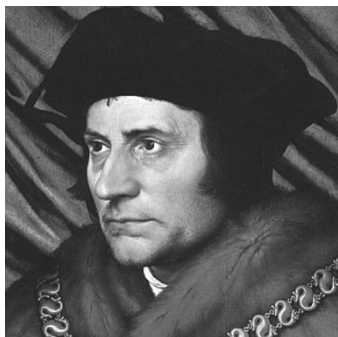

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Theme/Call To Worship

The readings for the Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time highlight the tension between God's desire for us to do his will and our human reluctance to trust and obey God.

Introduction To The Word

I Kings 19:4-8: The first reading, taken from the First Book of Kings, starts with Elijah's flight from Jezebel through the desert on his way to Beer-sheba. Exhausted from battle and desperate to escape, Elijah prayed for death. In response to his prayer, God sent an "angel of the Lord" twice to rouse and feed Elijah to strengthen him. Unbeknownst to him, Elijah faced a journey of forty days and nights that would lead him to Mount Horeb, where he would once again have a direct encounter with God.

Ephesians 4:30-5:2: In the second reading, from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, Paul urges believers to live a life of gratitude for what God has accomplished in Christ and to be "imitators of God" as his "beloved children."

John 6:41-51: The Gospel reading continues to highlight Jesus' "bread of life" discourse with the crowds. The Jewish crowds "murmured" against Jesus and Jesus offered a threefold retort to the question challenging his authority. First, no one comes to Jesus unless sent by the Father. Second, no one listens to Jesus unless they have learned to do so from the Father. And third, Jesus is the "living bread" that offers all who believe "eternal life."
