Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Theme/Call To Worship

The readings for the Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time speak to the daily ultimatum that faith gives us, to either follow the Lord or abandon the Lord and his teachings.

Today's Gospel reading is the disciples' reaction to Jesus' "bread of life" discourse. The reading opens up with the comment, "Many of Jesus' disciples who were listening said, 'This saying is hard; who can accept it?'" The "saying" is the entirety of Jesus' "bread of life" discourse. Jesus then asks these disciples, "Does this shock you? What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before?"—a foreshadowing of Jesus' ascension into heaven after his death and resurrection. Jesus concedes, "There are some of you who do not believe." He then concludes, "For this reason I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father." In the Gospel of John, true discipleship is defined by those sent to Jesus from the Father, and of the four Gospel writers John stands alone in recording the reality that "many" of his disciples in fact abandoned Jesus. But this abandonment becomes one of the defining moments for Peter and the Twelve as Jesus poses the question to them: "Do you also want to leave?" To which Peter responds: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."
