## January 27, 2019

### Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel reading for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time opens with verses from the Gospel of Luke and the start of Jesus' public ministry. In the first part of today's Gospel reading, we hear four historical and literary facts about Luke's Gospel. First, Luke tells us that "many" others are also compiling narratives on the life and impact of Jesus. He is referring to the Gospel of Mark, and may well be referring to the Gospel of Matthew, earlier versions of the Gospel of John and some non-canonical gospels, such as the gospel of Thomas and the Q sayings document. Second, Luke tells us he still has access to "eye witnesses" and "ministers of the word" in the writing of his Gospel. In other words, Luke belongs to the second generation of believers. Third, Luke has carefully investigated for himself the events associated with Jesus and has attempted to offer a fresh and more accurate and "orderly" perspective. And finally, Luke tells us who his audience is: "most excellent Theophilus" who scholars suspect may be the patron who sponsored Luke in the writing of his Gospel, since writing a Gospel would have been a costly and time-consuming endeavor. In the second half of today's Gospel reading, we hear about the start of Jesus' ministry in Galilee that will lead to his rejection at Nazareth.
