



Diocese of San Angelo World Youth Day Pilgrimage to Lisbon

July 30-August 8, 2023 - 10 Days

\$3,795 Per Person from Dallas (3 per room – 2 beds Limited number)

\$3,963 Per Person (2 per room – 1 or 2 beds - \$5217 single occupancy)

Sunday, July 30 Day 1 - DEPART USA - We depart Dallas to connect with our overnight flight to Lisbon. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast while aloft.

Monday, July 31 - DAY 2 - LISBON - We arrive in Lisbon, where we are met by our Tour Manager and given an orientation tour of Lisbon before “welcome” dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Tuesday, August 1 - DAY 3 - LISBON/ WYD WELCOMING – Today is free to explore Lisbon on our own while waiting for the official welcoming ceremonies for World Youth Day. Dinner is on our own. Overnight at our hotel

Wednesday, August 2 – Friday, August 4- DAYS 4 –6 – LISBON WORLD YOUTH DAY – Depending upon final World Youth Day Programs following full American breakfast at our hotel, we participate each day in appropriate activities and return to the hotel.

Lunches and dinners on our own or with WYD registration.

Saturday, August 5 - DAY 7 - LISBON WORLD YOUTH DAY AND VIGIL – Following the World Youth Day activities of today, we return to the hotel and then make our way to the site of the World Youth Day Vigil and Closing Mass, which will be officiated by His Holiness,

Pope Francis. We spend the night at the Vigil site.

Sunday, August 6 DAY 8 – LISBON/ WORLD YOUTH DAY CLOSING CEREMONIES – Our World Youth Day celebration comes to a close today with the Holy Father’s Mass. At the conclusion of the event, we return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Monday, August 7 - Day 9 - LISBON/FATIMA – This morning we journey to Fatima and visit the Basilica and Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima. We join the English language concelebrated Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions before a break for lunch on our own. We then visit the birthplaces of Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia, the Loco de Anjo and the Holy Way. We enjoy a final dinner before joining the International Rosary Procession by candle light. Overnight at our hotel. * Early morning flight departures will require the group to return to Lisbon after dinner for overnight.

Tuesday, August 8 - St. Dominic - DAY 10 – LISBON/USA – This morning, we return to the airport for our flight home with unforgettable memories and a renewed spirituality.

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare and land rates in effect July 23, 2021. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the final rates go up or down, an adjustment will be made prior to departure. As all services are contracted and prepaid on a group basis, no refunds can be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used. If you deviate from the tour, no consideration can be given to a refund for unused services. Prices are based on a minimum of 40 participants per group. Smaller groups will be combined to reach this minimum.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required. At the time of printing U.S. citizens DO NOT REQUIRE visas but may require COVID vaccination for Portugal. Citizens of countries other than U.S. -- please contact the Portugal consulate to determine visa requirements. Passport MUST be valid until December 8, 2023, or later.

AIR TRANSPORTATION International flight reservations will be made late in 2022. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON-REFUNDABLE.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected, centrally located hotels with private bath are provided. Triple, double and single room supplements will be charged as requested and available. If you do not have sufficient roommates and your host is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the appropriate room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: A full American breakfast is provided daily at your hotel except for the morning of the Closing Mass. **It is anticipated as in the past that your WYD ticket (Not included) will provide lunch and dinner during WYD and ample fast food and sit-down restaurants are found in the vicinity of your hotel. Two dinners or lunches described in the itinerary are included.**

Beverages are not included.

TIPS AND TAXES: All government and local taxes on hotels and meals are included. Tips to bus drivers, escorts, guides and hotels hostesses are included.

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: WYD Registration fee, passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, mineral water, sightseeing, optional excursions or services other than those specifically mentioned, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: All payments received will be applied to the total cost of the tour; **all payments received are non-refundable.** If reservations are made after previous payments are due, all previous payments must be made with the deposit. Credit cards are not accepted. All cancellations must be in writing to Unitours, Inc. via your tour host.
