Students desks will be arranged 3-6 feet apart and all facing in the same direction.



We do need to follow the directions on entering, parking and exiting in the parking lot.



All students in grades K-8, Faculty and Staff are required to wear a face covering.



Students should be dropped off at their assigned door where teachers will be there to greet and guide them safely into school.
