

## **Mass Schedule Changes**

**Since we reopened our churches in the Archdiocese some changes in the Mass schedule were made to accommodate the company that sanitizes our worship space after each Mass. When we first reopened we felt there would be a need to adjust the 10:30 am and 1:00 pm Masses in order to assure ample time was allotted for proper cleaning.**

**Since the Masses have been shortened, mainly due to having no congregational music, with exception of the 11:00 am and 1:30 pm Masses, as there is a cantor to sing the psalm response, alleluia verse and provide some music during Communion, we have found there is ample time for cleaning between Masses allowing us to return to our regular Sunday Mass schedule-8:30 am, 10:30 am and 1:00 pm.**

**I know you are probably thinking you just got adjusted to the change, and here change comes again! I apologize for the change, but there was about an hour and a half between the 11:00 am Mass and the 1:30 Mass. We were just sitting around 'waiting'. So, I have**

**So, when you register for this coming weekend Masses, please note the change as indicated on your reservation form. We are still having many 'walk-ins'. It is preferred you register, as when we hit the number that can be seated, and you 'walk-in', you will not be able to attend your Mass of preference.**

I don't know where all our young families are, but I hope you are watching the Mass as we live stream it at the 10:30 am and 1:00pm Masses. When we check the number of persons watching the live streamed Masses, the numbers are very low. What are you doing to assure you fulfill your Sunday obligation? Please remember we follow the guidelines of the Archdiocese of San Antonio not the guidelines of the City and County when it comes to Mass attendance. That red alert was a precautionary measure to assure people are following the mandated guidelines for safety for all people. It did not prohibit people from coming to Mass.**
