Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Attending Mass at St. Emile Parish

As of **October 5, 2021**, Provincial Covid Restriction Order on Religious services or faith-based gathering allows for 33% of normal capacity, which is equal to **99 people**, for St. Emile Parish. The Archdiocese of St. Boniface has given the direction not to check Immunization Status. Therefore, the new capacity follows the Provincial order which addresses potential attendance of unvaccinated individuals who are eligible to be vaccinated.

As we gather in faith, friendship, and brotherhood/sisterhood, each attendee is being asked to follow all current Covid-19 protocols.

These are:

- 1) Masks are **mandatory** in indoor public settings. A person who enters or remains in an indoor public place must wear a mask in a manner that covers their mouth, nose, and chin without gapping. Face masks are to be **worn at all times** except for those who cannot put a face mask on or take it off unaided, children under five, and those who are having immediate breathing difficulties.
- 2) Physical distance of two meters between households.
- 3) Self-screening the day of attendance and stay home when indicated.

Mass attendance will be on a first come first serve basis. Maximum capacity for Masses is determined by the ability to maintain social distancing between households and availability of live streaming in the chapel. When capacity is reached, a sign will be placed outside the doors and the doors will be locked. The province still requires that everyone attending Mass provide contact tracing information by signing in at all weekday and Sunday Masses.
