Dear Parents and Guardians,

It is a summer we will never forget, right? Because of the coronavirus, life is definitely altered. I hope you are enjoying summer in new ways.

Recognizing the many obstacles faced by parents in making numerous decisions about regular classes in the West G system, I have decided with conversations with my catechists (many of which are parents with school aged children) to as one option create a **Virtual PSR /catechist directed** program which would be consistently in place for the year 2020-2021.

The other alternative would be the **homeschool model**. Some of you have participated in it already. In this option, **parent(s) are catechists** (sometimes grandparents).

More information will accompany this letter. We have made a few changes which you will discover as you continue reading.

It is time now to register your child(ren) for our **Parish School of Religion (PSR)**. Please fill out the important forms, that is, the registration form, and the optional PSR program choice form: e.g. homeschool led by parent/guardian or our new virtual PSR led by catechist using Google Classroom.

Please be prompt in returning the forms. We depend on the information to take the next step in ordering books, creating classes, etc.

Checks should be made out to **St. Anselm PSR**. Though we would hope the registration form and fee payment would arrive together; it is **most important** that the registration form would come before our deadline. This year calls for early registration to design the digital program. Be sure to fill out all sections on **Registration Form**.

There will be a **late fee of \$5** per child if registration is not in by Mon. Aug. 10.

Oct. 3+4 are the starting days for PSR 2020-21

PSR Gr.1-5 sessions are from 9:00-10:00 Sat.(+ home activity during week)

PSR Gr.6-8 sessions are from 7:00-8:00 Sun.(+ home activity during week)

This program will be created for this 2020-21 year. Our hope is that 2021-2022 we will be back in the classrooms. How we all long for life as we knew it without the shadow of Covid-19.

We are looking forward in seeing the unexpected graces this year. The catechists also will be stretched as they creatively venture forward. Virtual PSR Program/ Catechist Directed

This program consists of

20 virtual Google Meets with catechist + class for lesson

6 streams on our parish website focusing on events of church calendar (Advent, Lent etc.), stories of Mary and the saints

Both will involve Google classroom activities

Each family needs a **gmail account designated for PSR**. Please make sure it is **not a school account nor school chrome books**, therefore, you need to have a home device and internet service available on the weekends at designated times.

Children under 13 are not allowed online without supervision (this is Children's Internet Protection Act).

Parent/guardian will need to acknowledge the catechist at the beginning of each and every class. You are welcome to stay or be in ear shot away. Depending on the grade level your presence may be needed for the entire session. Your presence may help focus your child, depending on age or ability level. You know your child's needs.

Homeschool Model/Parent Directed

This program involves the parent being the catechist. A manual or code for the Loyola Press will be given to you allowing you to access lesson plans, activities and evaluation tools.

You are also invited to participate in our 6 streams on our website throughout the year. More information will follow.

At the end of the year, I meet with the student whether in person or virtually to evaluate what has been learned.

Both programs use the same text and syllabus.
