I have been talking to many people in our program who are wanting to have children return to the building for PSR. I have talked to Father, Kathy Popelka, and Sue Pohly, our SAS principal.

We are making necessary adjustments to make returning to the building possible. The children here at SAS do not rotate classes, rather the teachers move class to class. Each child has his/her own desk. We are going to mainly use rooms that have tables rather than desks.

I think we are able to do this change as we return. I know that those of you who have already registered marked your choice of Homeschool or Virtual. Those who have chosen Virtual will be registered as In-Person and those who have chosen Homeschool will be registered as Homeschool. If you wish to change your registration choice, please call into the Parish Office or email to stanselmpsr@aol.com.

Those who have not sent in their registration yet, please do so as soon as you are able, keeping in mind that choosing Virtual will register you for In-Person PSR.

The form accompanying this letter also asks for volunteers who are willing to assist as an aide, a catechist, or catechist substitute. We also could use volunteers to assist as we begin our new year. Please print, fill out, and return the form to the Parish Office either by mail or by dropping it off during business hours.

There will be a need for volunteers for yard duty at the beginning and end of classes each week. This is needed for the safety of our children.

I wish to convey the various pieces of our total PSR program, grades 1-8, for 2021-2022.

In Person PSR / Catechist Directed

Our program for grades 1-5 will begin on Saturday, September 18, 2021 from 9-10:30 am, and grades 6-8 will begin on Sunday, September 19, 2021 from 7-8:30 pm. Only those who have registered before the 18th will be permitted in class on the first weekend. Any later registrants can join the following weekend. Our hope is that each PSR classroom will have both a Catechist and an Aide to assist in the instruction. Text books will be distributed in class.

Virtual PSR (potential)

In the event of a Covid related building closure, our program may convert to a Virtual model, using **Google Meet**, for the duration of the closure. Virtual PSR Consent Forms are required by the Diocese and must be completed, signed and returned by parents prior to the start of PSR (September 18, 2021).

Google Classroom

Google Classroom will be used as a form of communication, and as a teaching tool, during the PSR year. At the start of the program, students will be given an information sheet with the PSR Google account (Gmail) they are to use and their Catechist's PSR email address.

Homeschool Model / Parent Directed

This program involves the parent being the Catechist. A manual or code for the Loyola Press company will be given to you allowing you to access lesson plans, activities, and evaluation tools. You will also be invited to participate in any PSR special streamed sessions on our website throughout the year. More information will follow.

At the end of the year, I will meet with the student in person to evaluate what he or she has learned.

Both PSR and Homeschool models use the same syllabus.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

The fee for our program in 2021-2022 is \$45.00 per student and checks should be made out to St. Anselm PSR. Though we would hope the registration form and payment would arrive together; it is most important the completed registration form comes before our August 2 deadline. There is a \$5 late fee per child for registrations after August 2, 2021.

This program is created for the 2021-2022 year and we hope to adapt to the unexpected if necessary. We have done well in the past year with your cooperation and our teacher's creativity in making our PSR program a solid one. Thank you for registering your child(ren) with us thus witnessing the importance of our faith during these times. We look forward to seeing you again on September 18 and 19.
