

**It's important that when teaching our children prayers, they are hearing and saying the right words.** All of the misunderstandings on the front of this ebooklet were submitted by Catholic Icing readers as *real mistakes* their children were making when reciting their prayers.

Problems with mis-hearing parts of prayers can continue into adulthood if they go uncorrected.

**There are many ways to ensure that children are indeed getting the words right. Here are some ideas:**

- Repeat— The parent recites the prayer line by line, and the child repeats it back. You do this one child at a time. The parent listens to make sure the correct words are being said.
- Read— When your child is old enough to read, you can point to the words of the prayer as you say it, and have them follow along. This should help catch any misunderstandings.
- Write— Children can write the prayer out, ensuring that every word is being interpreted correctly.

**Each of the prayers in this ebooklet comes in 4 forms:**

1. Complete and in color. You can use these to hang up as mini posters for children to read at home or in the classroom, and for them to look at while they do copy work.
2. Trace the word. Each prayer is written out in dashed letters for younger children to trace.
3. Handwriting Paper. Primary paper is provided for early elementary children to copy their own prayer as they look at the complete version in color.
4. Lined Paper. This is for older children to write out the prayers, also using the complete, in color version as a guide.

(The Apostles' Creed does not come in these 4 formats. Because of the length of the prayer, the Apostles' Creed comes in a completed format, and a fill in the blank format where they place the missing words within the prayer.)
