If your child would like to enter, please bring a dozen cupcakes to the event by 6:15 P.M. in a disposable container with the label below filled out and attached. Any entries not labeled will not be judged. The cupcakes will be judged on flavor, presentation, and originality. One award will be given for each category. Parents, please remember this is a youth baking competition so let the kids do as much of the baking and decorating as you feel they can do safely. Entries need to be made by one student only please. The cupcakes will be judged during the first half of the performances and winners will be announced during intermission. Cupcakes will be sold throughout the remainder of the event for \$1.00 each. Water and coffee will be available as well.

**Gallery Walk:** During intermission the art gallery will be open for viewing and student artists will be there to talk about the different projects being displayed and answer questions. Please come by and see the amazing things they have created!
