

St. Thomas More Parish School Reopening Plan 2020-2021 School Year



What to expect when returning to school?

- Traditional School Setting - Face to Face or
- Non-Traditional School Setting - Remote
- Classes scheduled to begin on August 17th

How is STM preparing for the return of students in-person?

- Faculty, staff and students in 1st through 8th will be required to wear a face mask. Masks are recommended but not required for Prek and Kindergarten students. No "gaiter" type mask will be allowed.
- Visitors will not be allowed in the school.
- Temperature screenings will be done for students, faculty and staff daily during arrival
- No one will be allowed on campus with a temperature higher than 100°F.

What will my child's day be like at STM?

- Morning Carpool will begin at 7:30 am
 - **No Before School Care**
 - K-3 drop off at the gym doors closest to church
 - 4-8 drop off at Prinster Hall
 - PreK drop off in the preschool circular driveway
- Lunch
 - PreK-5th Grade will remain in homeroom groups and eat in classrooms
 - 6,7,8 will rotate between cafeteria, patio and classrooms
- Classrooms, Hallways and Restrooms
 - Only three students will be allowed at a time in the restrooms.
 - Restrooms will be sanitized three additional times daily.
 - PreK-5th will remain in their classrooms for the academic day.
 - 6,7,8 will remain in their classrooms for core curriculum but will travel for lunch and elective.
- Students will attend Mass by grade level groups
- Afternoon Carpool
 - Carpool will begin at 3:30 pm. Students will wait in homerooms until called.
 - Parents picking up children at walk up will wait outside the gate closest to the library.
 - PreK will begin carpool at 3:00 pm.



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What additional safety precautions will STM add?

- Additional Hand Sanitizer Stations and Handwashing Stations will be located throughout the campus.
- Restrooms will be sanitized three additional times each day.
- Students will not share classroom materials. Teachers will avoid the use of common material.
- Water fountains will be turned off. Everyone will need to bring a clear water bottle.
- Anyone exhibiting any of the following symptoms will be immediately isolated. Parents must pick up their child within 45 minutes of being notified.

Cough	Sore throat
Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing	Loss of taste or smell
Chills/repeated shaking with chills	Diarrhea
Muscle pain	Fever higher than 100°F
Headache	Close contact with a person who is lab-confirmed COVID-19

How is STM preparing for the return of students remotely?

Student who chose to attend school remotely will engage in synchronous learning. During synchronous learning students will be virtually engaged in the class that is taking place in real-time. Remote learners will be expected to:

- Connect to the class on time, following the given class schedule, including homeroom.
- Be in dress code and presentable during all virtual connections
- Show their face on the screen when engaging with the teacher
- Complete and turn in all assignments following the same timeline as students attending in-person
- Be an active participant of the class.
