IX. Cases which Require a <u>Dispensation</u> from the Local Ordinary:

- 1. Disparity of Cult: Marriage between a Catholic and a non-baptized person. (c. 1086)
- 2. Religious Vows: Marriage involving a person with a public vow of chastity in a religious institute. (c. 1088)
- 3. Consanguinity: Marriage between persons related in the third (aunt/nephew or uncle/niece) or fourth degree (first cousins) in the collateral line. (c. 1091)
- 4. **Affinity:** Marriage between persons related by marriage. (c. 1092)
- 5. **Public Propriety** arising from notorious and public concubinage in the first degree of the direct line.
