Hello, everyone! I wanted to reprint the key points from my bulletin column published last weekend:

1. After much consultation and careful research on how best to support those affected by the wildfires on Maui, we decided to make a donation on behalf of the Parish to the Hawai'i Community Foundation's **Maui Strong Fund**. 2. We'll be **restarting our in-pew offertory collection on the weekend of September 9-10**. I've heard many of you talking about how much your household budgets have been stretched over these past months. The same is happening here at the Parish and School, and we're hoping a return to passing the baskets will help remind folks to support our parish community.
3. Also on the **weekend of September 9-10**, we'll be

discontinuing our outside Communion station at the 9:30am Mass. Over the past few months, we've seen the number of folks using that station steadily dwindle as more and more of our parking lot crowd have returned to Mass inside the church. Please know that **we will continue to live stream the 9:30am Mass**, so if your health prevents you from coming inside, you can still watch from home or the parking lot. There's always a Communion station near the baptismal font for that Mass which you could come inside to receive from. Or, if you've been thinking about returning inside and have just stayed outside due to habit, consider this an opportunity to make the move. We'd love to see you again!

Best wishes to all of our teachers and students preparing to return to school in the coming weeks. Parents, hang in there just a little bit longer!

WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY

Join fellow Holy Trinity parishioners at Wednesday Bible Study to collectively grasp an understanding of God through His Word! *Acts: The Spread of the Kingdom* tells the compelling story of the first Christians, tracing how their witness of the gospel spread outward from Jerusalem and revealing how the seeds of Church structure and authority took root.

Presented by Jeff Cavins and Sarah Christmyer, this study helps us to see our place within the Church as a disciple of Christ, connecting the struggles and joys of the first disciples striving to live the life of Christ to our own struggles and joys today.

This is a **20-session study** that will begin on **Wednesday, September 13th** and run through early April. There will be breaks for separate Advent and Holy Week studies as well. We'll meet **weekly** from **9:00-11:00am** in the **Fireside Room**.

The study guide includes online access to the videos that will be watched together. Participants can purchase it directly from Ascension Press (about \$46 with shipping). **Financial assistance from the Parish is available, so do not let the cost prevent you from participating!**

FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH: THOUGHTS ON FAITH

As is normal in the Church, the greater feasts, like the *Assumption of Mary*, are echoed a week afterwards. We see this last week on Tuesday, August 22nd, with the *Memorial of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary*.

We've talked about the *Assumption of Mary* as one of the *two Marian Mysteries of the Rosary*. The second is the *Coronation of Mary*, which is related to the memorial we celebrated last Tuesday. Here we observe and honor that Mary, is both *Mother of God* and also *Queen*. At the time of Christ, the queen was not the king's wife but his mother; for example, King Solomon's "Queen" was his mother, Bathsheba.

We meditate and remember, that Mary reigns in heaven, not as God's equal, but because *she is the mother of Christ the King*. Her privileges come from her 'yes' to the message of an angel. Mary willingly agreed to become the Mother of God and to make redemption for us, possible. In turn, *Jesus, the King of the Universe, and our King*, shares His mother with us as both our mother and our queen.

Hail holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us; and after this our exile show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.

V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Amen. +
