Join fellow Holy Trinity parishioners at Wednesday Bible Study to collectively grasp an understanding of God through His Word! *Acts: The Spread of the Kingdom* tells the compelling story of the first Christians, tracing how their witness of the gospel spread outward from Jerusalem and revealing how the seeds of Church structure and authority took root.

Presented by Jeff Cavins and Sarah Christmyer, this study helps us to see our place within the Church as a disciple of Christ, connecting the struggles and joys of the first disciples striving to live the life of Christ to our own struggles and joys today.

This is a **20-session study** that will begin on **Wednesday, September 13th** and run through early April. There will be breaks for separate Advent and Holy Week studies as well. We'll meet **weekly** from **9:00-11:00am** in the **Fireside Room**.

The study guide includes online access to the videos that will be watched together. Participants can purchase it directly from Ascension Press (about \$46 with shipping). **Financial assistance from the Parish is available, so do not let the cost prevent you from participating!**

The Church celebrates *two important days* for *St. John the Baptist*: his birthday (June 24th) and his martyrdom (August 29th). This is as it should be for as Jesus Himself tells us, "*St. John is the greatest of the sons of men.*" St. John in his greatness leads a heroic and tragically difficult life.

Let's get to know St. John better. First, consider what *St. John* what was sent to do. A prophet before his birth, St. John leapt for joy in his mother *Elizabeth's* womb. St. John's mission was to proclaim to the world *the fulfillment of all prophecies: Jesus, the messiah and incarnate son of God!*

St. John preached repentance and conversion to ready the world for Christ. He did it courageously, knowing that he was announcing his own obsolescence. St. John, the greatest of all men, was the least in the kingdom of heaven. And with unparalleled fearlessness and determination gave his life for his savior. St. John is a major player in salvation history. We'll see more of St. John in Advent; until then, let's get to know him better.

Read St. John's story – his birth (Luke 1:5-25) and death (Mark 6:14-29) – and pray in gratitude for this great saint. St. John the Baptist, pray for us! +

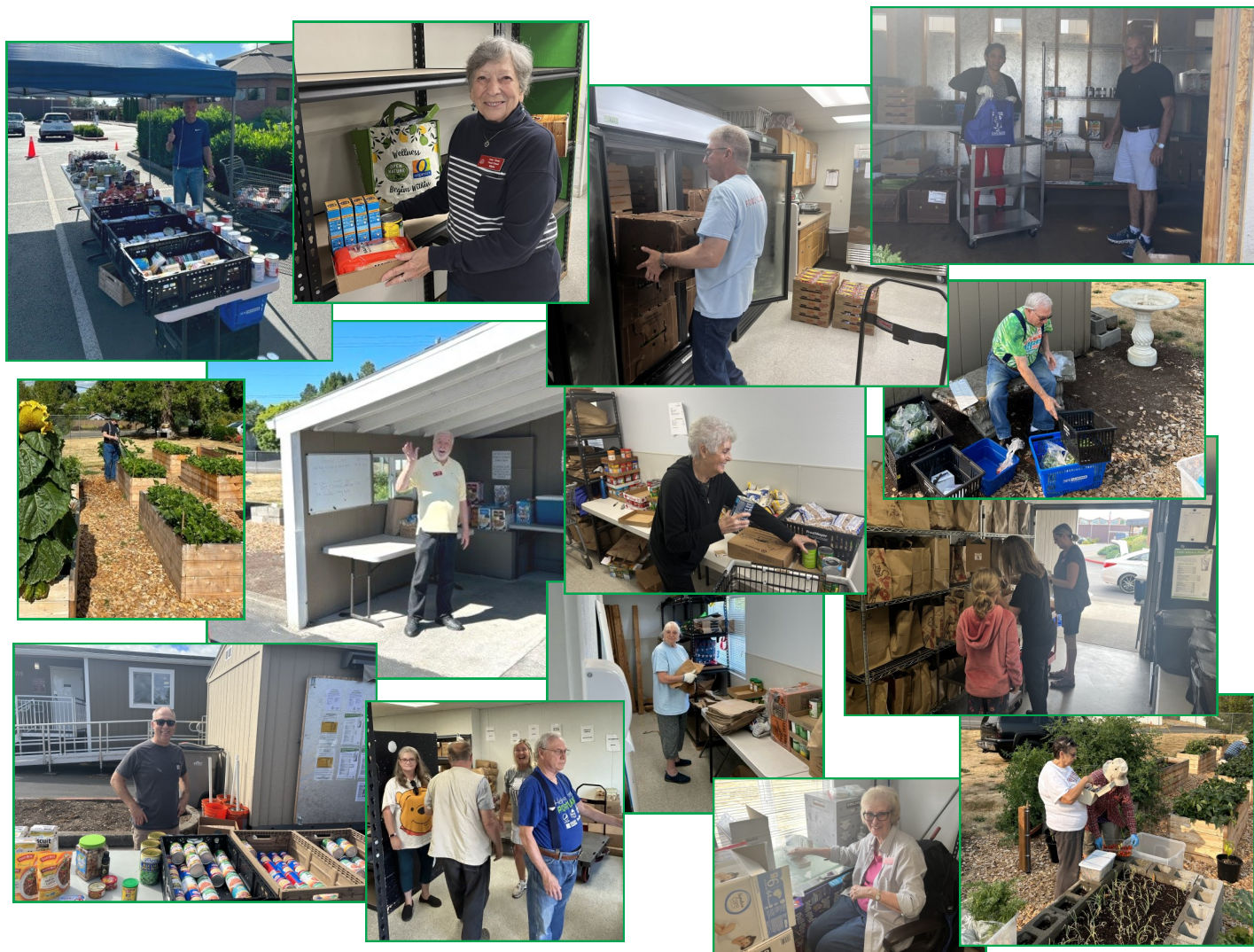
