THOUGHTS ON FAITH

Only *three birthdays* are celebrated on the Church's *liturgical calendar*. One is, of course, *Jesus'* birthday on December 25th. The second is Jesus' forerunner, *John the Baptist*, on June 24th. The third birthday that we celebrate is Jesus' mother, Mary, who is our mother too.

The Church celebrates her birthday on *September 8th*, nine months after the *Feast of the Immaculate Conception*. The dating serves a liturgical purpose in recalling the mysteries associated with Mary, similar to how the *Feast of the Annunciation* is celebrated on *March 25th – nine months before Christmas Day*.

As St. Augustine said of Mary, "*She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley. Through her birth the nature inherited from our first parents [original sin] is changed.*" So, on her birthday, let's consider celebrating Mary in a special way. Go to daily Mass if you don't usually go. Read the Gospel stories about Mary, like the Annunciation, the Visitation, and the Wedding Feast at Cana. If you have children in the home, consider making a cake and have it after dinner that day (I am sure the adults will enjoy it as well!). More than anything, may our celebrating lead to creating an important place in our hearts and homes for Mary.

Holy Mary, Mother of God and our Mother, pray for us! Happy Birthday, Mary!

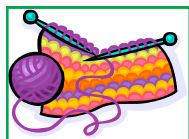
Memorial of St. Peter Claver – September 9th

St. Peter Claver was a Jesuit missionary from Spain who dedicated his life to serving enslaved Africans in 17th century Colombia. He vowed to be “the slave of the slaves forever” and met every slave ship entering the port to provide medicines, food, and assurances of God's love for them. He also travelled from plantation to plantation, tending to the slaves physical and spiritual needs and exhorting the plantations owners to treat them humanely. During his 40 years of ministry, Claver baptized an estimated 300,000 slaves.

St. Peter Claver, you who worked to protect the human rights and human dignity of the most vulnerable members in society, continue to inspire in us this same spirit of care for our brothers and sisters. Help us to see the image of God in all whom we encounter as we work to end modern day slavery in the form of human trafficking.

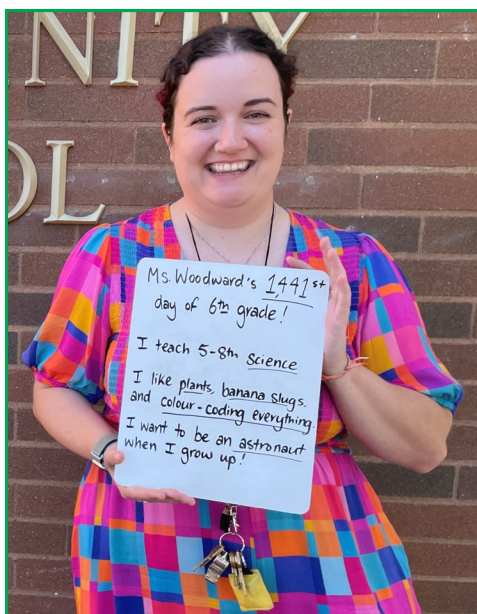
