Lastly, I want to draw your attention to a very important opportunity that is coming our way in a few months, November 30th – December 2nd. The Archdiocese will be hosting Dr. Bob Schuchts (founder) and Sr. Mirian James Heidland, SOLT, and team from the John Paul II Healing Center for their "Healing the Whole Person" weekend conference. The goal is to "promote and inspire transformation in the heart of the Church, by healing and equipping God's people for the New Evangelization."

I have personally benefitted from the John Paul II Healing Center's work on several occasions when they came to minister to us priests here in the Archdiocese. This group represents the best of Catholic outreach to help us all heal from the wounds that bind us. It will be offered at Our Lady of Lavang's new parish campus in Happy Valley (very near Clackamas Town Center). Several of our staff will be in attendance, so hopefully we will see you there. 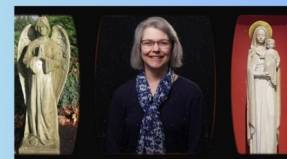

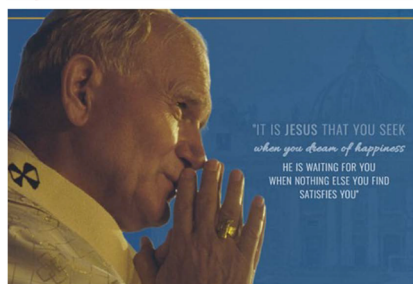
