

The staff of the man whom I choose shall sprout. Thus I will rid myself of the Israelites' grumbling against you. - Numbers 17: 20








Moses told them: "This is what the LORD has ordered to be done." Bringing forward Aaron and his sons, Moses first washed them with water. - Leviticus 8:5-6




**The Lord, however, had not chosen the nation for the sake of the place,
