Dispensation to End Easter Sunday

Bishop Silva announced that effective Easter Sunday, April 4 or as of the Easter Vigil, April 3, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, which has been in effect since mid-March, 2020 will end. However, anyone who is sick, may have been exposed to anyone with Covid-19, or who has a health condition that would endanger themselves or others by being present in church, continues to be dispensed.
