CRS Rice Bowl is sponsored by Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and the Archdiocese of Portland. This Lenten solidarity and faith-formation program is conducted in Catholic parishes within the archdiocese. 75% of funds are used for international relief and development projects. 25% of all money given is made available for projects within the Archdiocese of Portland that address hunger and poverty.

- 1. The requesting organization must be located in the Archdiocese of Portland.
- 2. The request must benefit those who suffer from hunger or poverty. Beneficiaries must currently reside in the Archdiocese of Portland. Grant money may not be used for salaries or wages.
- 3. The project and its leaders must not be in conflict with Catholic moral and social teaching.
- 4. Organizations' activities must not engage in partisan political activity.
- 5. What Catholic affiliation or relationship with the Church does your project have?
- 6. Applicants must demonstrate a willingness to collaborate with the Office. Please state how your organization is or will be in relationship with the Office of Life, Justice & Peace.
