



The Christmas Season is a special time to ponder the Mystery of the Incarnation, Jesus, the Son of God, taking on human flesh to dwell amongst us. For Catholics, Christmas begins on December 25th and ends eight days later because we can't limit the celebration and reflection upon Jesus' Incarnation to one day. Savor, ponder and celebrate the gift of the Christ-child during these special days.


