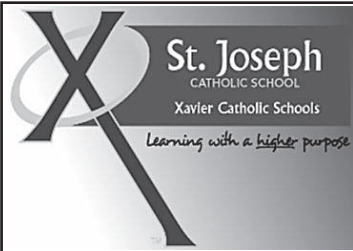

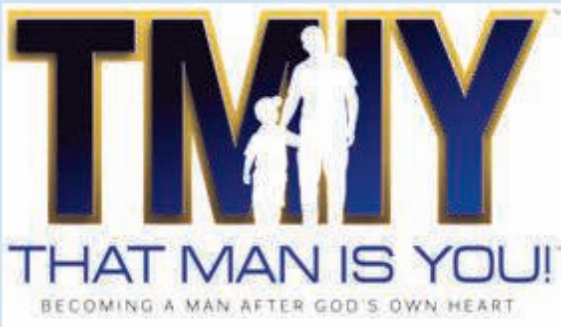
Valentine’s Day Couples Banquet


