


Knights of Columbus of Iowa Retreat November 3-5, 2017 (Begins 8:00 p.m. Friday and ends on Sunday with lunch)

All Saints Day—November 1st, is a Holy Day of Obligation this year. The Vigil Mass will be celebrated on Tuesday, October 31st at 6 PM. The Mass of the day will be on November 1st at 8:15 AM. **Please note that there will be no morning Mass at 7:30 AM on Tuesday, October 31st.**

All Saints Day celebrates the company of believers in heaven saved by Jesus. We know the names of some who are in heaven because they are our canonized saints. There are countless others, however, who have faithfully followed Christ, sought the forgiveness of their sins, and lived his way while gracing this good earth. They aren't officially canonized and may or may not have passed through Purgatory first, but certainly are dwelling with God forever in heaven.

This day accentuates that a living part of our Church is in heaven, the goal and purpose of our lives. We have a heavenly company, thank God, who cheer for us, intercede for us before the Throne of the Lamb, Jesus our intercessor before the Father. They inspire us to holiness and show us the way to live our lives in preparation for heaven. Praise God for this beautiful day and for our heavenly intercessors!

All Souls Day—will be observed on November 2nd. The parish Mass is at 7:30 AM.

On this special day, we exercise the laudable and charitable practice of praying for the dead. It is comforting to do so and expresses that death does not end our relationship with the deceased. We are mindful, too, that no one is perfect upon death and that there may be unfinished matters, that is unforgiven sins that were not absolved before death or other life matters/imperfections requiring attention, before passing through the gates of heaven. The Church teaches the existence of Purgatory as a place of purification before a person enters heaven. On this day, we pray for the souls in Purgatory that their time there might be expiated and that they soon enter into eternal glory.

Of course, we need not restrict our prayers for the dead to one day of the year. All Souls Day is a model of what we can do every day for the deceased.
