



St. Joseph Day, March 19th-Since the celebration of our patron saint occurs on a Sunday of Lent this year, it is transferred to Monday, David March 20th, because it ranks as a O'Connor solemnity due to the important role St. Joseph played in our salvation.

Our celebration on Monday can be festive, even in Lent, during which time your Lenten penances may be relaxed. Observe the day with prayer and thanksgiving. Plan to stop by the church and pray before the Blessed Sacrament, as the time of exposition is from 7 AM to 9 PM. Ask for St. Joseph's intercession to protect our Church and particularly our parish dedicated to him. Pray for all fathers, and especially if you are a dad or a grandfather, that they may imitate the example of St. Joseph in faith, prayer and family.
