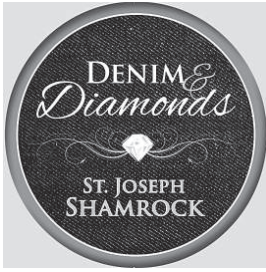

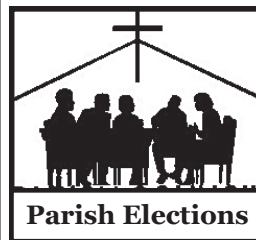

The Pastor's Pen



Easter Greetings—One of my favorite quotes from the psalms is what we pray today, “This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad.” It sounds like the psalmist (the psalm writer) is happy for the gift of another day. True enough, but understood through the eyes of the resurrection, it takes on a transcendent, eternal meaning. Jesus’ resurrection from the dead is a new day like has never been seen before.
