



Mother's Day—Our observance of this special day invites a reflection upon Jesus' Mom, the Blessed Mother. I admire much about her, but today, these accounts from her life come to mind.

After the birth of Our Lord and as the events of his life began to unfold, we are told that Mary cherished all of these things in her heart. She took her son to her heart, the center of her being, cherishing and reflecting upon him there. At the Wedding of Cana, she was an integral part of the inauguration of her Son's public ministry, telling the waiters after the wine was exhausted to, "do whatever he tells you," as Jesus worked his first miracle. She spoke as a true mother who believed in her son. Lastly, before Jesus was born and while she was pregnant, Mary visited Elizabeth, her elderly kinswoman, who was with child.
