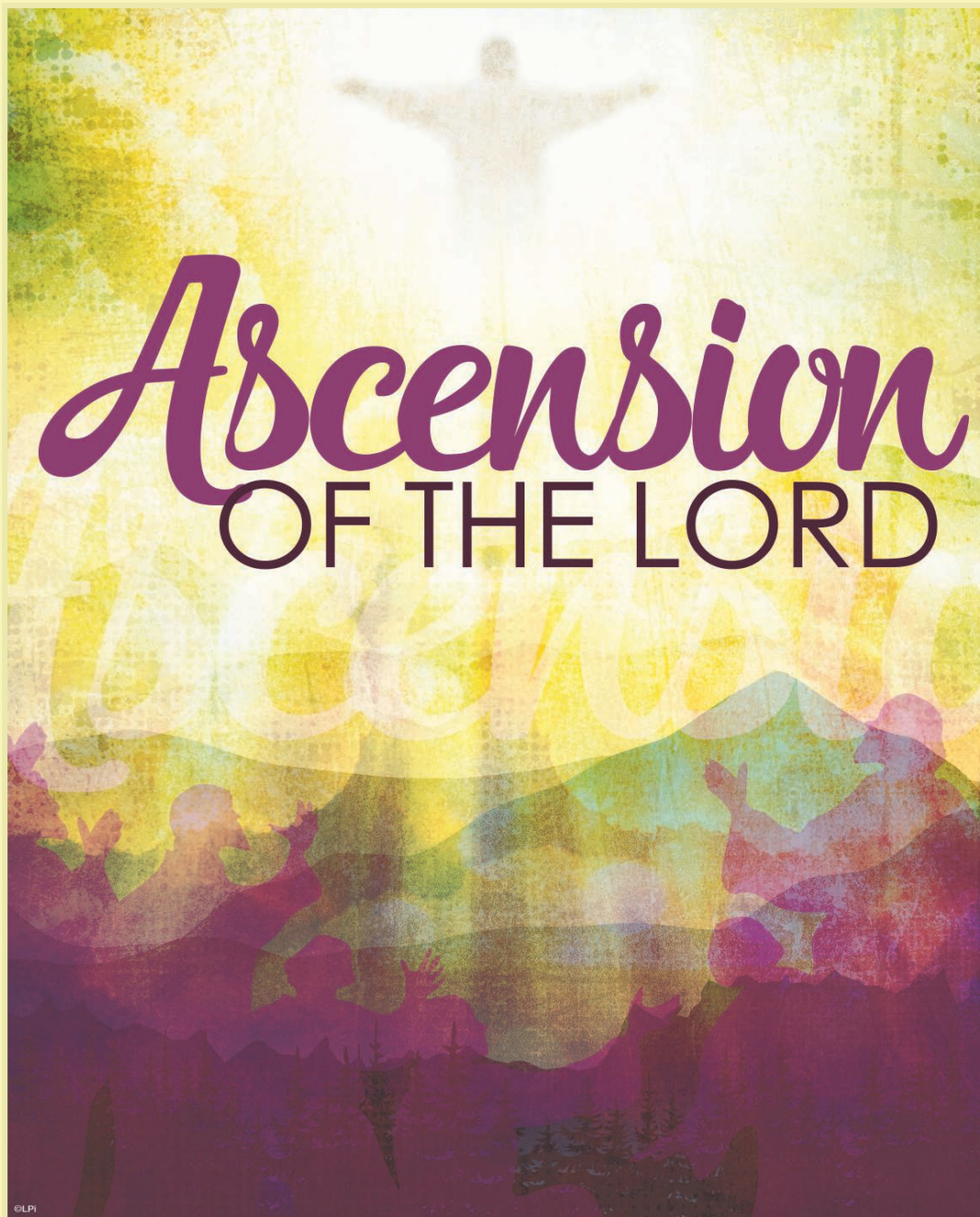

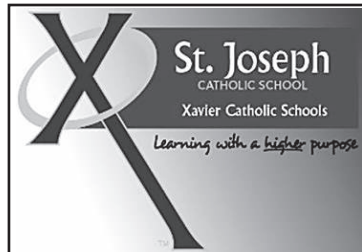

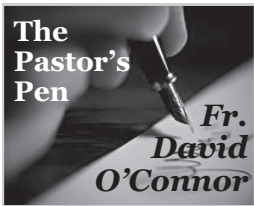
Dealing with Grief and Guilt as a Family Caregiver

The Pastor's Pen



The Ascension of Our Lord— This great celebration is part of the Paschal (Easter) Mystery, which is Jesus' death on the cross, his resurrection and ascension into heaven.

The Ascension is a multifaceted mystery. Saint Matthew's gospel proclaimed this weekend, depicts Jesus giving himself as a parting gift to his disciples (know that I am with you until the end of the age) through the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus is present to the world through the Spirit. In turn, the disciples were given as a gift to the world to tell all about Jesus and to make disciples, baptize and teach. Jesus gives them the authority and the Spirit offers the power to fulfill Jesus' mandate. The celebration of the Ascension says that you, as a member of the Church, are a disciple and have received the gift of the Holy Spirit. Go into the world with strength and courage to make disciples. You do so by the authority of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit.

Wednesday Weekday Mass Time—Since St. Joseph School has dismissed for the summer, the Wednesday weekday Mass time will change to 7:30 AM, and shall be such until the beginning of the new school year in the fall.

Pentecost Sunday—will be celebrated the weekend of June 3-4, and is the culmination of our observance of the Easter Season. The liturgical color is red which signifies the Holy Spirit in terms of the tongues of fire (red) that appeared over the heads of the disciples on Pentecost. I've noticed that a lot of people wear red that day either intentionally or accidentally. Whatever the case, feel free to wear red as a way of participating in Pentecost, the birthday of the Church through the gift of the Holy Spirit.
