



Holy Trinity Sunday—Think about how the Church observes a calendar year. The new year begins with Advent followed by Christmas. We begin the year by ultimately contemplating the mystery of the Incarnation, that

Jesus took on flesh to dwell amongst us. The Blessed Virgin Mary conceived by the Word (Jesus) of the Father through the work of the Holy Spirit. The reflection continues in that the Father sent the Son who revealed God fully. Jesus is the fullness of God's revelation. The Holy Spirit was sent by the Father and the Son on Pentecost to be our Advocate and to continue the mission of Jesus until the end of time. Every Church year we are blessed to reflect upon and participate in God's self-revelation during our celebration of the Mass and other liturgies of the Church

We've reached a point in the liturgical year after Christmas, Good Friday, Easter, the Ascension and Pentecost, that we celebrate a feast dedicated to the Most Holy Trinity. God is a mystery, but has revealed Himself as three persons; Father, Son and Holy Spirit in one God. We would never know anything about God were it not for His self-revelation. What we have learned is that God calls us to the very intimacy of the Trinity itself. He welcomes us into a personal relationship with Him, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We know that God is love who calls us in love to share a loving relationship with Him. You can prayerfully reflect upon that for a lifetime, and hopefully you will, which will lead you to an eternal participation in the life of the Trinity in heaven.

Rosaries in Support of Christians in the Holy Land--Rosaries brought back to St. Joseph from the Holy Land pilgrimage are available for purchase outside the main church entrance on this weekend and next. Simple in design and yet profound in symbolic significance, these rosaries were handcrafted from the wood of olive trees by Christian families living in Bethlehem. 
Wine & Wisdom Series
