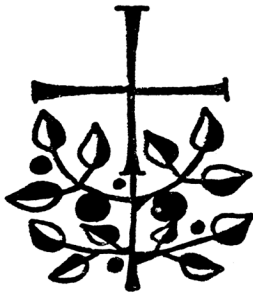





Easter Sunday
